



**lost** : when someone is lost he can't find his way or he doesn't know where he is

**child** → **children**

**buy** : get something by paying money

**fast** ≠ **slow**

**fast** : rapid; quick

**cheap** : low in price

**cheap** ≠ **expensive**

call the emergency(115)

donate blood




**voluntary work** : *something that you do without getting money*
