
service : the action of helping or doing work for someone





take out money from an ATM



send : *post; mail*

send ≠ receive; get

E-mail : *electronic mail*

send an e-mail



hire : *get; rent*


hire a taxi



account : *when you want to use bank services you open an account in the bank*

open an account

put out : *to stop fire*

put out fire

recharge : *charge your account again by paying money*

e-ticket : *electronic ticket*

recharge your E-ticket

emergency : *something dangerous or serious, for example an accident, that happens suddenly*

call : *contact by phone*

call the emergency(115)



ask ≠ answer

Information desk : *a place where people get information in a public place like an airport*

ask the information desk

donate : *give*

blood : *the red liquid in our body*

donate blood



voluntary work : *something that you do without getting money*

do voluntary work
